Three-year Academic Scholarships are available for students in Year 7 in 2023.

Two-year Academic Scholarships are available for students in Year 11 in 2023.

All applicants are invited to sit the Scholarship Exam which is held at Freshwater Christian College. Academic scholarships attract a 50% reduction in fees for the duration of the scholarship. Academic Scholarships are assessed through formal examination of the following areas: general reasoning, mathematics, reading comprehension, spelling, and written expression. High achieving candidates will be short-listed and invited for an interview with the Principal.

In addition to completing this form, all students applying for an Academic Scholarship need to register and sit for the ACER Exam to be held at Freshwater Christian College.
