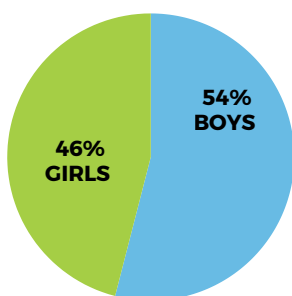

Freshwater Christian College is a leading co-educational independent Christian College educating learners from Preparatory to Year 12.

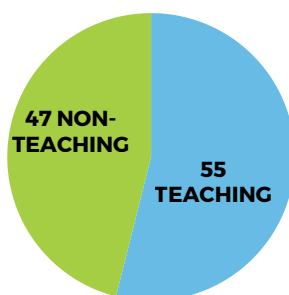

Year 12 Outcomes

35 students were awarded a Senior Education Profile (SEP)

35 students were awarded a Queensland Certificate of Education (QCE)

3 students completed a school-based apprenticeship or traineeship (SAT)

26 students awarded one or more VET qualifications:

- 15 students were awarded a Certificate II
- 24 students were awarded a Certificate III
